Second largest group of regulated health care providers in Nova Scotia and are absolutely vital to the delivery of safe, efficient, ethical, competent and sustainable care. There are currently nearly 3,700 LPNs in Nova Scotia. The College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Nova Scotia (CLPNNS) is the regulatory authority for LPNs in the province and is responsible for establishing, maintaining and monitoring practice standards to be met by all LPNs. The scope of practice of the LPN has evolved over the last number of years in response to increases in the educational requirements and changes to the legislation and regulation that supports their practice. The scope of a profession outlines the range of roles, functions, responsibilities and activities its members are educated and authorized to perform. It sets the practice boundaries for all its practitioners. This workshop will discuss the scope of practice of LPNs in Nova Scotia as well as other practice concepts key to LPNs in today's healthcare environment.

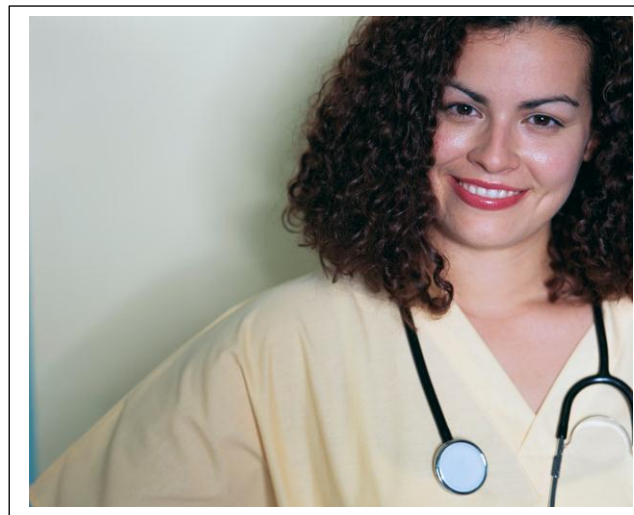
