## College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Nova Scotia



The College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Nova Scotia (CLPNNNS) recognizes licensed practical nurses for their demonstrated, significant accomplishments and commitment to the nursing profession. CLPNNNS is pleased to have instituted several awards as recognition to individual licensed practical nurses in Nova Scotia.

### Excellence in Preceptorship Award

The award recognizes a licensed practical nurse (LPN) for their exemplary ability to provide guidance and support to colleagues and students. This LPN has contributed to the teaching and education of colleagues or students within the health care system.

### Criteria

- Demonstrates a willingness to share their time and knowledge to be a preceptor
- Demonstrates outstanding clinical competence within the nursing profession
- Demonstrates a professional approach to preceptorship with colleagues and students
- Demonstrates advocacy within the preceptoral relationship
- Demonstrates a supportive and collaborative approach while providing guidance to colleagues and students
- Applies CLPNNNS Standards of Practice and Code of Ethics within their nursing practice

### Eligibility

The nominee for the Excellence in Preceptorship Award must be in good standing and currently registered with CLPNNNS. This preceptoral relationship should have occurred within the past 3 years.

Nomination forms can be obtained by contacting the College by mail, phone or by downloading the nomination form from the webpage.

### Selection Process

1. The deadline for award nominations is February 28<sup>th</sup> of each year.
2. The CLPNNNS Provincial Awards Committee, approved by the CLPNNNS Board, will coordinate a review of the nominations from each of the 6 regions.
3. Each of the 6 regions will randomly review another region's nomination applications.
4. The Provincial Committee will select one recipient from the regional nominees.
5. The selection will be based on well defined criterion as listed.
6. The award recipient will be recognized at the CLPNNNS Annual General Meeting (AGM) in May of each year.
