Lifetime Achievement Award

The award acknowledges a LPN for their significant contributions to their profession. This LPN has demonstrated a lasting impact on their practice.

Criteria

- Demonstrated an exemplary contribution to LPN practice over the past 25 years or more
- Demonstrates a commitment to the growth of the LPN profession over the span of their career
- Demonstrates leadership through advocacy for the profession and application of their Standards of Practice
- Demonstrates a commitment to life long learning by being a positive role model
- Demonstrates the characteristics of a professional LPN
- Demonstrates excellence in collaboration and communication within the interdisciplinary team

Eligibility

The nominee for the Lifetime Achievement Award must be currently registered and/or has retired in good standing from CLPNNNS.

Nomination forms can be obtained by contacting the College by mail, phone or by downloading the nomination form from the webpage.

Selection Process

1. The deadline for award nominations is February 28th of each year.
2. The CLPNNNS Provincial Awards Committee, approved by the CLPNNNS Board, will conduct a review of the nominations.
3. The Provincial Committee will select one recipient from the nominees.
4. The selection will be based on well defined criterion as listed.
5. The award recipient will be recognized at the CLPNNNS Annual General Meeting (AGM) in May of each year.
